- Demonstrate support of the Urban League’s mission to assist African Americans and others in achieving social justice and economic equality.

Rising Community Leader Award Criteria

Nominations for the Rising Community Leader (Youth) category will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- Full-time undergraduate or graduate student at an institution of higher education in Hampton Roads. A student campus organization may also be recognized.
- Must be in good academic and disciplinary standing and demonstrate a balance of academic, community and co-curricular excellence.*
- Evidence of contributions to the lives of others.
- Demonstrate support of the Urban League’s mission to assist African Americans and others in achieving social justice and economic equality.

*The nomination also requires a name, phone number and email address of someone at the college or university who can certify the nominee’s academic standing.
