Rising Community Leader Award Criteria

Nominations for the Youth Leadership category will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- Full-time undergraduate or graduate student. A student campus organization can also be recognized.
- Must be in good academic and disciplinary standing and demonstrate a balance of academic, community and co-curricular excellence*
- Evidence of contributions to the lives of others
- Demonstrate support of the Urban League’s mission to assist African Americans and others in achieving social justice and economic equality.
